The Brick Campaign is off and running! As a congregation, we are anxiously awaiting the day when we can see our bricks and pavements proudly displayed on the grounds of our new facility.

The good news is the deadline to make a purchase has been extended until Corinthian breaks ground. Our hope is that the congregation continues to realize the importance of this investment in our church and those still interested will make a purchase. Not only is this act an investment in our church, it’s sowing a seed into our community while leaving a lasting legacy.

The inscription on your brick/paving stone can display your name, honor someone else or memorialize a loved one. Remember, the cost of a brick and/or stone is very affordable. Bricks start at \$100.00 for 3 lines or 39 characters and Paving Stones are \$300.00 for 162 total characters.

Brick sales are every 1st & 3rd Sundays and a representative will be in the Adult 2 classroom to take payments or answer any questions. Payments can be made in as little as \$10.00 increments.

Don't miss out on this opportunity! Once we begin to break ground, the builders will need to have a final number and the option to buy will no longer be available. Will you be in that number???

This is simply a program where people can leave a final gift to our church in support of all the valuable things we accomplish in our community.
