## Background

- Believed to be the oldest book in the Bible. Because of the type of Hebrew in the book and the events listed in the book. And, although the book of Job talked about Satan, Job himself never recognized Satan, Law of Moses, or Israelites and their customs.
- Authorship is uncertain. Options; Job, Elihu, Moses, and Solomon. Therefore, since the authorship is uncertain then the date of the writing of Job is uncertain.
- The book of Job is one of the books of poetry in the Bible
