Introducing CBC’s Design and Review Team

The process of building a new church and family life center requires focus and extreme attention to detail. The Design and Review Team brings both those elements to the table.



Deacon Robert Starghill, Vice-Chair of the Design and Review Team is supported by Deacon Derrick Byndon, leader of the Family Life Center Committee and Trustee Wynndel Burns, leader of the Church Design Committee. These three men make up the core team and are charged with the overall design and review of the building plans for the two new facilities. They bring exceptional experience to the table as all three are professional engineers allowing them to have a broad prospective on problem solving and core competency on “building things”.

The overall goal for this team is to be in a position to present a conceptual design of our new church and family life center within 6-8 months of 2013. Conceptual square footage for both the church building and FLC has been outlined along with spatial requirements. Also, criteria for vetting and selecting an architect has been defined. The team will proceed towards conceptual designs for both buildings once the site master planning has been completed and the architect is chosen.

In their quest to understand the needs and desires of the congregation, CBC members have been asked for their input. Until a final design has been generated, the team will continue to accept and review submitted requests.

Keep on working until it’s done! That’s the motto of this team. They are using their skill sets to bring substance and to expand opportunity for CBC members to minister more effectively not only to each other but to the Bond Hill Community.
