Genesis 3 - Part 2

1. Verse 6 - "Eve took of the fruit..."

• Headship – although Eve took the fruit, Adam (the man) was responsible for his family, 1 Timothy 2:11-14, Romans 5:12.

2. Verses 16 – 19 - Punishment for disobedience

Work was not a punishment because of their disobedient. The work became harder, more difficult.

- We have to work on self and our relationships just like Adam and Eve had to work on their land to grow crops.
- 3. Genesis 2:17 "for in the day that you eat from it (the tree of knowledge) you shall surely die."
 - Does that mean a 24-hour day? Evidently not because Adam lived to be 130 years. However, we don't know how long Adam and Eve lived in the garden nor how long after being put out the garden.
 - Some believers say that according 2 Peter 3:8 Adam didn't live one day.

4. Verse 24 – "So He (God) drove man out (the Garden of Eden)"

 God wanted to prevent them from eating from the Tree of Life, Genesis 3:22.

5. Verse 6 – "She gave to her husband with her, and he ate."

Was this a prophetic picture of how Jesus bore our sins?

1 Peter 2:24, Isaiah 53:4-5, Leviticus 16:22, Romans 5:17-21.
