

Genesis – Chapter 4

Verse 17 – “And Cain knew his wife” – One of the most asked questions concerning Cain is, “Where did Cain get wife from?” The most popular belief which I believe is Cain married his sister or a niece. Adam and Eve and their children had many children. But only the boy children are recognized.

Verse 14 - Also, it was the relatives that Cain feared would kill him after he killed his brother Abel.

Genesis – Chapter 6

Verse 2 – “...sons of God saw the daughters of men...” The two popular schools of thought are, one, that the sons of God and the daughters of men represent the righteous and the wicked; the seed of the woman versus the seed of the serpent and the family of Seth versus the family of Cain.

And the second view is that the sons of God represent angels or demons; Job 1:6, 2:1, 38:7, Jude 6, 7, 1 Peter 3:19, 20, Matthew 22:30

1 Enoch (noncanonical book) states that the children of heaven saw and lusted after them (daughters of men). It could had been that Satan tried to corrupt the seed of the woman.

Verse 4 – The union between the sons of God and the daughters of men produced “**giants**” on the Earth.

Verse 3 – This doesn’t always mean that God’s Spirit will not always be with us. The emphasis is on “120 years.”

Verse 21 – Methuselah name could mean “When he dies it shall come.” This could be a prophecy about the coming flood.
