What was the purpose of God bringing light into the world on the first day? What was God trying to get us to see? Your thoughts?

Day 1

There are Bible scholars that believe that the 7 days of creation present our relationship with Christ. If this is so, then the first day is all about how we see Christ.

- John 1:14 says, "And the Word became flesh, and dwelt (tabernacled) among us, and we beheld His glory (as in the glory cloud), the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth."
- John 1:6-9, the true Light
- 1 John 1:1-7, God is Light
- James 1:17, Father of Lights

As the songwriter said, At the Cross, At the Cross, where I first saw the Light, and the burden of my heart rolled away...

Just like trees, vegetation, animals, and humans cannot grow without light, there cannot be spiritual survival and growth without light. Notes: below the sky. Some believe that the waters above the sky are clouds. Others believe this water is a canopy that goes around the Earth. And there is water below the Earth. That is why when it rains hard it causes floods, Genesis 7:11.
Psalm 150:1 – "Praise ye the LORD, praise God in His sanctuary: Praise Him in the firmament of His power." Wherever there is sky (firmament) God is to be praised. notes:
